Our church family has recently had the privilege and joy of working as an Angel Team, welcoming and supporting our new member, Byron Alexander, in his ongoing and inspiring successful return to the community.

- A former inmate in the San Francisco community needs your God-provided prayer as he needs to find living-wage work by the end of this month.
- Embraced:Fully is embarking on a very exciting online prison program to reach 1 million incarcerated individuals with courses that will enable them to attain what Mary Baker Eddy describes as “moral freedom”.
- The immediate need is for funding to support new personnel and a video production crew to meet the needs of new people requesting mentoring prior to their release from prison.
- Embraced:Fully assists inmates in attaining “moral character transformation” as well as providing resources and guidance upon release from prison.
- There is a need for new Angel Team churches to sprout up around the country to come together in love and support for these deserving individuals.
